## Jerwood Makers Open Call for Entries: A new applied arts initiative from Jerwood Visual Arts

Jerwood Visual Arts launches Jerwood Makers Open, a brand new annual exhibition series designed to support and showcase new work by emerging artists in the applied arts. Jerwood Makers Open follows Jerwood Contemporary Makers, which ran from 2008 to 2010.

Jerwood Makers Open begins in 2011 and will run for up to three years. Each year, four bursaries of £7,500 will be awarded to makers submitting proposals for new work or works. These works will then be exhibited in a group show as a key part of the Jerwood Visual Arts programme at Jerwood Space, London. Makers will be selected by an independent panel of leading practitioners, curators and academics.

Jerwood Makers Open has been developed to create a space in which to recognise and celebrate the significance of making practice and process within contemporary visual arts. This new initiative will also offer an open submission opportunity for makers at the early stages of their careers to develop their creative ideas independently of specific commissioning structures.

The deadline for entries is **21 February 2011** and applications are open to artists across making disciplines. Applicants must be within 10 years of graduating or setting up their practice and must be resident in the UK.

The Jerwood Makers Open exhibition will be at Jerwood Space, London, from 13 July to 28 August 2011.
